

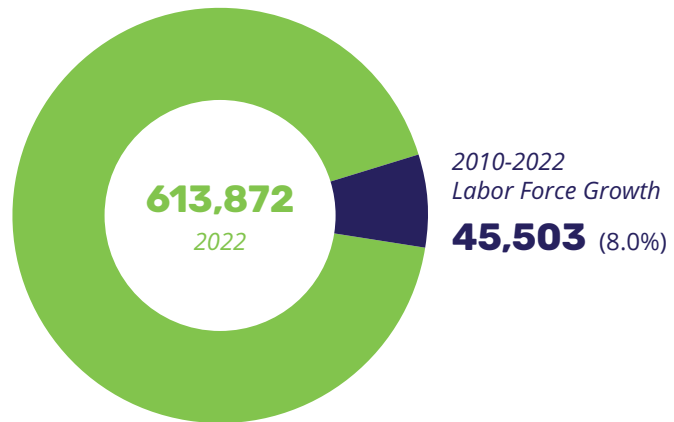

### Life Sciences Industry

Huntsville's growing life sciences industry is primarily focused on genomics and genetics research and applications with more than 50 life science companies employing over 1,000 workers.

### HudsonAlpha Institute for Biotechnology

Established in 2006, **HudsonAlpha** has its roots in the Human Genome Project of the 1990s. The \$200M center is located on 152 acres in Cummings Research Park and is designed to support genomics-based research to improve human health and well being.

### Research & Technology

Huntsville's **Cummings Research Park (CRP)** has earned a reputation as a global leader in technology development. The second-largest science and technology research park in the U.S., CRP is home to 320 companies and 26,500 people involved in technology research and development.

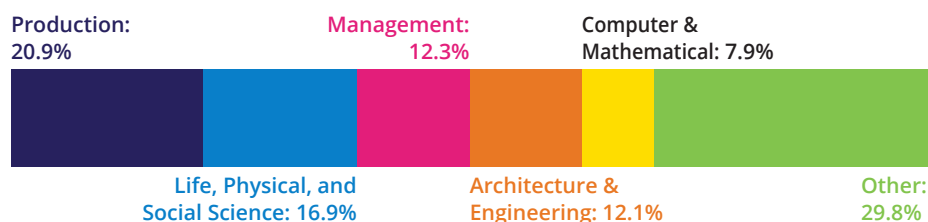
